TIGER HEART raced close up inside while in hand, came wide into the stretch, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. POTRISUNRISE (ARG) chased the pace from the outside and finished gamely to earn the place award. EXCITING METRO quickly showed in front, set the pace and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. BAILERO (ARG) was urged along inside, altered course to the outside in the stretch and lacked a rally. INAMORATO raced between rivals, was steadied on the turn, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SILVER FLOWER broke slowly, raced inside and had no rally. ADMIRALTY ARCH was outrun along the inside. RECORD BUSTER broke awkwardly, raced three wide and tired.
