Footnotes

PICKAPOCKET rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace under pressure while saving ground, shook loose at the top of the stretch, opened a commanding lead in midstretch and held sway while being kept to the task. HOLIDAY TRIP tucked in behind the leaders for six furlongs, took up chased after the winner entering the stretch and finished willingly to clearly best the others. EQUAL steadied along the rail on the first turn, tucked in behind the leaders along the backstretch, raced in good position to the turn and held late to gain a share. ROMP (ARG) stalked the leaders three wide for six furlongs and finished evenly. LE DAUPHIN lunged in the air at the start, was under a snug hold along the inside while well back to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. NORTHERN DUKE pressed the pace outside the winner to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. BLAZING DYNAMO was outrun early after breaking slowly, never reached contention while racing wide. FREE OF SECRETS failed to threaten while saving ground. JEDOUM raced wide throughout after breaking slowly. LEMON DROP HIGH steadied sharply between horses on the first turn and failed to menace while wide on the turn.
