RODMAN tucked in along the rail while in hand, angled three wide on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch and wore down the runner-up in deep stretch. SODA POP KID stalked three wide leaving the turn, gained a slim lead in midstretch and yielded grudgingly. DREAM AGAIN was outrun for a half, circled four wide into the stretch and finished strongly but could not get up. BANKING HOLIDAY raced in close contention while three wide into upper stretch and finished evenly. ELIXIR set the pace on the rail into midstretch and tired. LION KINGDOM failed to mount a serious rally. HAVE YOU EVER pressed the pace along the rail for five furlongs and gave way. CROSS THE ATLANTIC was outrun after breaking slowly.
