DANCE FLOOR MANIAC settled just off the pace while off the rail, came under some urging while between rivals on the turn, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, accelerated when switched to a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker and surged past FUZZY'S STORY late under steady right hand encouragement. FUZZY'S STORY quickly assumed command, controlled the tempo while inside on the turn, extended the lead when set down in upper stretch, maintained a clear advantage into the final sixteenth but was caught. ALWAYS ON THE MOVE settled on the outside, came under a ride while four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. LION'S LAIR tracked the leader on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came under a vigorous ride near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the leader into the stretch and weakened. FULL TILT NOOGIE broke about a length behind the field, settled at the rear, saved ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to rally. CAPRIDGE came out at the start, settled on the inside, was urged along while saving ground on the turn, came up empty in upper stretch and dropped out.
