Footnotes

KIMONO broke inward at the start, showed good speed, set the pace under some pressure, controlled the action on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under hand urging in upper stretch, held a sizeable lead into the final furlong and proved best under moderate hand urging while shown the whip. KANSAS was well placed just off the pace, moved out some near the half-mile pole, was urged along while near the inside on the turn, came through along the rail in upper stretch, moved into second outside the eighth-pole, chased the winner in the final furlong and finished willingly to just get the place. LIBERTY GIRL was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, continued under right hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly to just miss the place. RAINBOW DREAMS chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, was given a tap of a down-turned whip outside the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and tired. GRAND MERE settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. GARMENTOS GIRL was a bit reluctant to load, pressed then chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and weakened. SANDSARITA was in tight at the start then drifted out early, angled closer to the inside with five furlongs to run, settled while under some urging, moved in near the half-mile pole, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn and was no factor.
