Footnotes

COSMIC ENERGY took the inside route before slipping into the two path nearing the end of the backstretch, picked up interest when let out a notch late on the turn, entered the stretch and got set down, took charge past the eighth pole, dug in gamely to fend off the late threats coming from each of the next two finishers. ARSENAL unhurried while saving ground under a good hold from the pilot, angled out and split rivals at the five-sixteenths marker, was called upon just before turning for home, displayed a good kick en route for the place. WET ONE (IRE) well rated while saving ground for just nearly three-quarters, came home with good late foot down the outside of the course. BAY HEAD BEAUTY assumed a forward position, was taken in hand and allowed to idle between calls down the backstretch, allowing a troubled SHEZA HEARTBREAKER sufficient time and space to escape to the outside, was cued up and advanced towards the leader once this was done, made a successful challenge to take over leaving the midway point on the second turn and was soon cut loose, felt the winner's presence nearing the end of the furlong grounds, yielded before reaching the sixteenth pole and backed away. WISE HARMONY three wide on both turns, tired. FIRST WHIPPOORWILL was bumped by an errant SHEZA HEARTBREAKER at the break, was three wide on the first turn but closer to the inside until the head of the stretch, gave way after going six furlongs. GIANT SLEEP showed the way from the inside, under, as circumstances would have it, little pressure for the initial half, had BAY HEAD BEAUTY crank up it up just after going a half, proved powerless to turn back that one's challenge at the five-sixteenths pole and faltered. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER broke outward making contact with the nearest opponent, proceeded along with a slipped saddle with the rider losing and or kicking out of both irons shortly afterwards, advanced forward down the backstretch until just having the pacesetter in front, was taken well out in the middle of the course, out of everybody's way and eased.
