MOLLY MORGAN was hustled from the start, secured a good position on the inside while under urging, saved ground on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, chased the leader, moved out passing the furlong marker, bumped lightly with CAVIAR N CHAMPAGNE while shifting out more near the sixteenth-pole and got up at the wire. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER came away in good order, showed good speed, set the pace while a bit off the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. ROYAL SIGHTING bumped twice with STATUS PENDING at the start, settled towards the inside, was roused on the turn, advanced near the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip while chasing the leader, switched to a right-handed whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker, gained on the outside and just missed in a three-way photo. CAVIAR N CHAMPAGNE tracked the pacesetter, inched closer to that rival near the five-sixteenths, was asked at the quarter-pole, pursued the leader under a right-handed whip, bumped lightly with MOLLY MORGAN while between rivals near the sixteenth-pole and weakened late. PRINCESS MARA was restless in the gate, came away well then was hustled, raced on the outside while urged along, chased three to four wide on the turn and tired. BID A MOON settled on the outside, lugged out while four to five wide on the turn, straightened in upper stretch and failed to respond. MARVELOUS MARGARET broke in and bumped with STATUS PENDING, settled just off the pace, threw her head a bit and dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, went two to three wide on the turn and came up empty. LILY LYNN showed no speed while hard ridden, dropped well behind, went three wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. STATUS PENDING was bumped multiple times on

both sides at the start, eased back between those rivals, was reserved at the rear, raced in hand while behind horses leaving the backstretch, went three wide early on the turn, dropped to the rail outside the five-sixteenths pole, failed to respond when called upon and faded.
