Footnotes

SO LONESOME came out a bit at the start, showed early speed then was urged along while just off the pace, dropped back midway down the backstretch, was ridden along while mostly in the three path on the turn, moved closer at the five-sixteenths, came between rivals at the quarter-pole, idled behind BLUE COLLAR CAT after turning into the stretch, was roused when that rival dropped closer to the inside shortly thereafter, chased under a right-handed whip, drew on even terms passing the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under good handling. BLUE COLLAR CAT veered out at the start but broke in front, showed early speed then stalked the leading duo on the outside, was asked while four wide early on the turn, dropped to three wide while moving closer to the leaders, gained the advantage outside the quarter-pole, inched clear into the stretch, dropped close to the inside while under a drive at the three-sixteenths, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. SOCIAL REBELLION bobbed at the start but recovered quickly, settled near the back of the field, ranged up while inside on the turn, waited behind the pacesetting duo from the five-sixteenths pole into the stretch, angled out when finally asked near the three-sixteenths, came under the whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and safely secured the show then was eased up late. THUG DADDY broke about two lengths slow, was hustled then moved to the outside, raced off the pace while under urging, advanced four to five wide on the turn, loomed a threat coming to the five-sixteenths pole, chased under the whip into upper stretch, drifted out outside the furlong marker and flattened out. SLEW'S BREW was hustled from the start, disputed the pace on the inside, dropped out turning into the stretch and tired. TESTOSTERSTONE contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, dropped out coming into the stretch and capitulated.
