Footnotes

HOT TEMPO off the inside throughout, commenced the run around the far turn from the three path, advanced steadily into contention, was asked for a response and spun one path wider into the stretch, closed in with a rush to appear to poke a head down in the front with an eighth to go, held on well enough long enough to preserve the decision. BOZIQUE made it over on to the inside route narrowly before arriving at the top of the opening bend, got clipped from behind by a rank FLATTERMEWITHROSES shortly afterwards, temporarily lost her best action, tipped outward after spinning into the backstretch, continued to be unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest by just a notch and swung five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and charged willingly into a contending position by the completion of the next furlong, maintained the momentum, finishing with a flourish, but came up shy at the wire. CHLOE BEAR was steadied after being squeezed back from between rivals in the early stages, resisted the rating hold being used by the pilot right afterwards, rankly fighting against the bit and climbing briefly heading for the end of the homestretch, took the three path on the first turn, remained at a considerable distance from off the rail thereafter was six wide and full of run turning for home, rallied belatedly to earn the show. INSOLVENT rated near the inside until the quarter pole, lost the lead coming to eighth pole and weakened. TIE DYE under a snug hold during the opening stages, saved ground, saw CORINTHIANNA abandon the pocket entering the stretch, launched a rail rally along the newly-created clear passageway, loomed boldly by midlane, failed to sustain the move and backed away. CORINTHIANNA contently tracked the front runners from the pocket, was put to encouragement and

angled out spinning into the stretch, issued an abbreviated challenge and tired. LEMON SONG three wide on both turns, had no rally. FLATTERMEWITHROSES tucked along the rail after the start, was rank and hard to handle entering the first turn, clipped the heels of BOZIQUE, bobbed and had the rider lose his balance momentarily, popping out of the right iron and nearly out of the other one as well, went on to save ground and was no factor. LADY UTOPIA strung out three wide on the opening bend, chased the leader from the two path on the subsequent one, was put to solid encouragement by the five-sixteenths marker, gave way.
