ERIUGENA (IRE) hesitated slightly at the start, crossed to the two path into the first turn settling into mid pack as the field spread out early on a bit, remained patiently handled as the field took closer order on the front into the far turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung two to three wide into upper stretch, got presented a clear path between foes and rallied through splitting rivals a furlong out, then inched clear through the late stages to prevail kept busy to the wire. LOGAN STREET steadied lightly at the break getting off last as foes on both sides broke his way but were corrected prior to any contact or squeezing, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied offering up good energy to move into the place honors inside the final sixteenth with too much to do to get to the winner. AN IMAGINARY ROAD four wide in mid pack, bid from three furlongs out four wide through the turn coming under further encouragement at the five-sixteenths, rallied to take narrow command a furlong out, led briefly until overhauled a few strides later, finished mildly for the show honors. PROFESSOR CHAOS saved ground towards the rear coaxed along from the half mile pole and offered up a mild kick for the last major share. TRAININGFORSUCCESS three wide towards the rear, got set down swinging four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to pass tired rivals through the late stages. UNCLE MITCHO forwardly placed two to three wide in aim of the leader, came under urging three furlongs from home, cornered three wide for home, fought on mildly to the eighth pole before weakening late on. HARDROCKER three wide in close range of the front, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide into the lane and weakened in the drive. SUMMER SANDS coaxed just off the pace just off the inside, cut the corner into the stretch roused, bid mildly to the eighth pole before flattening out through the final furlong. FLOWING MANE on the pace in hand just off the inside, got let out nearing the quarter pole, got headed at the three-sixteenths and steadily gave way.
