GALLOPING GAL checked in traffic on the first turn, was unhurried for a half, worked her way forward between horses on the turn, split rivals to get clear in upper stretch, charged to the front leaving the furlong marker then drew clear under steady urging. MISS BERGDORF steadied then bore out on the first turn, raced well back for a half, steadied in traffic between horses nearing the far turn, worked her way forward from outside entering the stretch then finished well to gain the place. SMASH HIT was shuffled back a bit after the start, steadied while being carried very wide on the first turn, trailed along the backstretch saved ground while launching her bid on the turn, split rivals while gaining in midstretch then rallied belatedly. SAVORY raced just off the pace while three wide to the turn, lodged a bid to threaten in upper stretch and weakened late. ALEXI DANCER alternated for the early lead along the inside, moved out along the backstretch, came back on to challenge on the turn then tired from her early efforts. WHERE'S BOBBY B steadied and ducked out on the first turn, raced far back for five furlongs, steadied along the inside on the far turn, raced in traffic at the quarter pole, steadied while lacking room in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. CHASE LAKE steadied in traffic along the backstretch, raced six wide to the turn tired. EL PRADO'S GAL raced just off the pace while saving ground to the turn, steadied along the inside in midstretch then tired. BERKSHIRE PRINCESS set or forced the pace to the top of the stretch and tired. OPENLY steadied a bit on the first turn, raced up close while five wide to the turn then gave way.
