SAINTLY ACTION angled to the inside on the first turn, moved up along the backstretch, raced in good position while saving ground to the far turn, moved through along the rail to take charge at the three-eighths pole, extended her lead in upper stretch then held off CLOAKOF VAGUENESS under intermittent urging. CLOAKOF VAGUENESS was unhurried for six furlongs, angled in while gaining on the turn, rallied along the rail entering the stretch then closed steadily but couldn't overtake the winner. LITTLE BONNET trailed to the turn, swung wide at the top of the stretch then rallied belatedly. BO'S SISTER moved off the rail entering the backstretch, moved between horses on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. BEL BAIE failed to mount a serious rally while wide throughout. ASHRAAF forced the pace from outside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. DANDY ROSE set the pace under pressure to the far turn and gave way.
