SIMPLY BRILLIANT was reserved early while between horses, angled four wide entering the stretch then closed steadily in the middle of the track to wear down PSYCH in the final strides. PSYCH pressed the pace from outside into upper stretch, surged to the front inside the furlong marker, continued on the lead into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. MEDAL OF FREEDOM dueled heads apart along the rail into midstretch and weakened. QUIES was rated just inside the winner while saving ground to the turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. EVERY TRICK checked in traffic on the far turn, trailed while four wide to the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response when called upon. DEB'S CHARM chased the leaders while three wide for a half and gave way.
