

SENSE OF STYLE came away well, raced close up outside while in hand, moved to the leaders approaching the stretch, responded when roused, quickly drew away and was under a vigorous hand ride to the wire. MISS MATCHED stumbled at the start, was bumped after the start, was urged up along the inside, argued the pace into the stretch, was no match for the winner and dug on the rail to hold the place. PLAY WITH FIRE bobbed at the start, was outrun early, came wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. BROADWAY GOLD raced four wide while in hand and had no response when roused. PUNCH APPEAL was bumped at the start, was outrun early and had no rally. PORTSEA quickly showed in front, set the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. CLASSIC ELEGANCE was bumped at the start, showed speed along the inside, was shuffled back entering the turn and tired.
