Footnotes

NEHANTIC KAT was unhurried along the backstretch while saving ground, moved out on the turn, swung four wide entering the stretch then unleashed a strong late run to win going away. RAUSEHENBACHS HALO dueled between horses for a half, exchanged bumps with SISTER SHIP while battling heads apart into midstretch then outfinished that one for the place. SISTER SHIP never far back, moved through a narrow opening along the rail to challenge on the turn, alternated for the lead along the inside while bumping repeatedly with RAUSEHENBACHS HALO into deep stretch and yielded late. KARAKORUM KNOCKOUT dueled for the lead three wide into upper stretch and weakened from her early efforts. CHEQU'ER ALIBI ducked out at the start, angled to the inside on the far turn, saved ground to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. FLYING SAPPHO was outrun for a half after breaking well behind the field, circled five wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. KATHLEEN'S CHANCE never reached contention while saving ground throughout. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
