Footnotes

CARRIAGE TRAIL raced in midpack while saving ground, gradually gained while saving ground on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch, drifted out considerably while closing the gap into stretch and wore down MADAME DIVA to win going away. MADAME DIVA dueled early along the rail, shook loose leaving the turn, continued on the front into midstretch and yielded grudgingly. CALLA LILY was outrun early after breaking slowly, bumped with JOYEUX RULER at the half mile pole, followed the winner on the turn, swung wide at the top of the stretch, altered course to the inside of CARRIAGE TRAIL in upper stretch and closed late to gain a share. BURLETTA bumped twice at the start, moved up from outside, lodged a mild bid four wide on the turn and weakened in the stretch. CHRISTMAS LILY bumped twice at the start, raced between horses to the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. KARLA'S NUMBER pressed the pace from outside for five furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. PATRIOT FAN raced up close early between horses, dropped back on the turn and faded in the stretch. SWEET SEPTEMBER stumbled badly at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. JOYEUX RULER broke slowly, was bumped between horses at the half mile pole, angled in on the far turn and never reached contention.
