Footnotes

MONTAUK rushed up to contest the early pace, duelled heads apart into upper stretch, briefly relinquished the lead inside the furlong marker then fought back gamely to get up in the closing strides. GOWDEN MILE stumbled at the start, rushed up along the rail, pressed the pace inside the winner for five furlongs, surged to the front leaving the furlong marker battled into deep stretch and yielded late. FORZA BRUTA steadied sharply between horses along the backstretch, checked in traffic nearing the far turn, raced in midpack to the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole and closed late to gain a share. SKYPA settled early, lodged a four wide move to challenge on the turn and faded in the stretch. KING TALLYMON steadied early then checked along the inside nearing the half mile pole, advanced three wide on the turn, swung six wide entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. RENOWN pressed the pace three wide between horses to the turn and tired. DECKMATE ducked in at the start, steadied repeatedly in traffic along the backstretch and into the far turn, advanced six wide into the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. HONORABLE RULER was pinched back early and was never close thereafter. HE'S CHARMED hesitated at the start, altered course to the outside along the backstretch, raced five wide to the turn and gave way.
