Footnotes

VICTORY FOR SIERRA was reserved for a half, angled four wide while gaining on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch, battled heads apart with SAVASANA into deep stretch and bothered that rival while coming in during the closing strides. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run VICTORY FOR SIERRA was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in the late stages. SAVASANA sprinted clear early, set the pace along the inside into the stretch, dug in when challenged in midstretch, battled into deep stretch and clipped the winner's heels and stumbled in the late stages. ARE WE DREAMIN raced in close contention along the inside into upper stretch and finished willingly while angling out late. WINLOC'S IRENE stumbled after being bumped leaving the gate, was unhurried for six furlongs, rallied between horses entering the stretch and closed late from outside. PRIVACY was outrun to the turn and drifted seven wide at the quarter pole. WINLOC'S HAIL MARY steadied along the rail on the first turn, saved ground for six furlongs, checked along the rail on the turn and was never close thereafter. GRAND CAYMAN was outrun into upper stretch and steadied along the inside in deep stretch. SHE'S THE CURE pressed the pace three wide and tired. TOO TIRED TONIGHT raced wide throughout and gave way.
