### Footnotes

BOBBI O. was well placed just behind the leader while saving ground, eased out while gaining on the turn, took charge at the quarter pole, opened a wide gap in midstretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. ROGUE'S JEWEL was reserved early, circled four wide on the turn and finished well to clearly best the others. DREAM TRAIN raced in good position on the backstretch, moved three wide while gaining on the turn then flattened out in upper stretch. MYRTLE'S GRAY broke in the air at the start, raced well back just off the rail for a half and improved her position late. HEAR HER ROAR was never a factor. SMOKE AFTER SIX rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace inside to the turn and gave way.
