### Footnotes

TAP FOR LUCK underwent a three wide pursuit while coaxed along, issued her challenge for the lead when ready coming to the quarter pole, closed in readily, drawing abreast of the leader at the eighth pole, took charge a few strides later and edged clear under constant right handed encouragement. MISS DORA was lightly urged to secure the pocket position, kept pace with MY SOUTHERN STAR just enough to deny that rival an opportunity to swing over to the inside until the five-sixteenths pole, spun along the rail into the stretch, still prominently placed, had intentions of angling out for the stretch drive, but was forced to hold off executing the plans until the top one went by outside at the three-sixteenths pole, proceeded to angle outward, responded well, having now been put to encouragement, came home willingly but had to settle for place honors. CADAZZLE bobbled at the break, raced within range along the outside, was given her cue turning for home, but was outkicked. MY SOUTHERN STAR advanced to the front, despite hitting the ride side of the gate, tried to duck over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, only to be denied by runner up, finally did so, after edging away, approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a notch after entering the stretch, felt the top one's presence at the eighth pole, offered brief resistance before succumbing and continued weakening during the last eighth. ALSEERA off inside, was no factor. BAYOU TORTUGA away well, displayed greenness during the run around the bend, swung three wide into the lane, attempted to lug in soon after settling in, and failed to reach a contending position. ROLY POLY GOALIE trailed.
