FUNKY MUNKY MAMA away alertly, despite being bumped at the start, established command in short order, cut the pace from the two path under a firm hold, was set down to a vigorous hand ride and drew off with authority. MILLIE MONEY saved ground throughout and rallied for the place. BUTTONFRONT unhurried along the outside, was along for the show. HARDWICKE HALL bumped at the start, chased the top one until the eighth pole before backing off. KITTEN'S KITTEN bumped at the start, was outrun during the initial going, commenced to rally while being fanned from the outside into the lane, was widest off all at the head of the stretch, and was moving well late. COPIOUS NOTES alternated between the four path and the overland route around the turn and had little left to offer after turning for home. NO ANGEL off slowly after breaking inward, was never involved. ADRIATIC PEARLS forwardly placed off the inside, folded. JET FEVER underwent a three wide pursuit and gave way. MORE IS MORE four wide around the turn, tired. MISS MARLA chased the leader until the top of the lane and faded.
