Footnotes

PERSUADING raced three wide on the first turn, moved to the lead entering the backstretch, was well rated with an easy lead, controlled the action while a bit off the rail on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held sway under right hand urging. KITTYLICIOUS shifted to the rail in the early going, settled on the inside, came off the rail early on the far turn, moved closer as the field started to bunch, lacked room from the top of the stretch to the three-sixteenths pole, moved around COLOUR THE WIND coming to the eighth-pole, split rivals and was asked for her best then finished well but was too late. KATHERN'S KITTEN raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. STORM SHOWERS took an awkward stride when KITTYLICIOUS dropped in early then was taken up a bit, was taken in hand while just off heels entering the first turn, raced off the pace while under some restraint, went three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide at the top of the stretch, jostled with FRANCES GARDNER near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. EXCHANGE FUNDS was rated while in hand and off the rail, shifted three wide and was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. COLOUR THE WIND set the early pace on the inside, relinquished the lead leaving the first turn, tracked PERSUADING down the backstretch, was roused in upper stretch, had room on the inside but lacked the needed response. FRANCES GARDNER bumped lightly with MORE IS BETTER in the early going, settled near the back while saving ground, continued inside through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, jostled with STORM SHOWERS near the sixteenth-pole and also lacked the needed response. QUEEN HAZEL was unhurried at the back, shifted four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MORE IS BETTER stumbled badly at the start then was taken up, bumped with FRANCES GARDNER while eager nearing the first turn, moved up while three wide on that turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, raced just behind the leader while two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 18 Feet)
