Footnotes

FOX RULES contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, rating kindly under a good hold from the pilot, briefly gained a clear alleyway, as WESTERN TRYST came outward at that juncture, but chose to disdain it, began a three wide angle into the stretch approaching the quarter pole, with the rail once more shut down tight by the leader, kept pace with the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, gained ground more readily thereafter, grabbed the lead away leaving the sixteenth pole and edged away under good handling. UNBRIDLED COMMAND bumped at the start, took up a forward position, stalked the leader from the outside down the backstretch, left the half mile pole three wide, continued the pursuit, moved up to pressure the leader midpoint on the far turn, bumped lightly with an errant WESTERN TRYST in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, yet pressed on, was set down spinning into lane, kicked away to a comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong, felt the top one's presence about a sixteenth down the road, yielded soon afterwards, finished willingly to secure the place. WESTERN TRYST broke alertly and sped off to an open lead under his own power, was rating while setting the opening splits, facing only mild resistance until well past the half mile pole, started to bear out from the three-eighths pole, as pressure from UNBRIDLED COMMAND arrived, rubbed shoulders making light contact with the previously mentioned rival late on the turn, reacted well to the rider's corrective course of action, turning for home once more placed along the inside, offered brief resistance before relinquishing in upper stretch, eventually weakening into the third slot. MISSISSIPPI DUEL made contact with VAN TASSEL at the start, took up position in midpack along the outside, departed the backstretch three wide, was given some rein early on the far turn, only to be placed back in hand, as VAN TASSEL went zooming by in the four path midpoint, sat reserved off the inside for the remainder of the run around the far bend, found his best stride leaving the eighth pole to grab the last major award. SWAG DADDY appeared unsettled early in the race, shying away from outside pressure coming from the runner up soon after the start, acted more professionally thereafter, raced three wide around the second turn, lacked the necessary response. ROYAL BLESSING saved ground and was no factor.

VAN TASSEL bumped between rivals at the start, was strung out in the three path on the first turn and down the backstretch, launched a four wide sweep coming to the three-eighths pole, entered the stretch a bit wider but soon flattened out. IDA'S PRIDE three wide at the head of the stretch, had no kick. POST PATTERN grabbed hold leaving the starting gate, lagged behind for nearly three-quarters, angled outward approaching the three-sixteenths pole, failed to make any headway on the front runners. ROCK STAR CHARLIE rated attending the pacesetter from the two path for six furlongs, tired.
