Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 since August 1, 2011, 4 lbs.; three races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered.) Preference by condition eligibility beginning with stake winners. Ties broken by total earnings. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Monday, August 13 2012 with 10 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (S)

RISKY RACHEL lost her footing at the break but quickly assumed a forward position, departed the backstretch three wide, moved up to draw abreast of FINAL MESA midway on the turn, went head to head with that opponent the rest of the way to the quarter pole, was still on even terms with the previously mentioned rival when asked for a response entering the stretch, readily gave it, taking charge during the run through the furlong grounds, drew well clear, crossing the wire under a vigorous hand ride. WILLET was taken off the inside route past the half mile pole, got asked to pick up the pace heading for the top of the stretch, came home willingly although no match for the top one. PAPER PLANE saved ground, got asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into upper stretch and rallied well enough to be up for the show. FINAL MESA sat entrenched in the two path, raced head to head with the eventual winner from the three-eighths pole until the upper portion of the furlong grounds, drifted inward while falling back slightly, near the three-sixteenths pole, resulting in the rider of LADY VI altering course, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole then tired. LADY VI took up position along the inside once the runner up vacated the premises, made a menacingly move from the seven-sixteenths pole under her own power to loom boldly arriving at the quarter pole, turned for home with clear passageway awaiting along the inside, but not for long, altered course after FINAL MESA drifted inward in upper stretch, soon flattened out. SUPERIOR SARAH chased the front runners from the outside, was four wide at the head of the stretch, had no rally.
