HOLIDAY'S JEWEL fought the bit while eager on the initial straightaway, continued to resist the rating tactics of the rider while under restraint on the outside, leaned in leaving the backstretch, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid in upper stretch, battled side by side with GEISHA GAL while under a right-handed whip in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. GEISHA GAL tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, was given one crack of a right-handed whip then switched to the left hand, battled with HOLIDAY'S JEWEL in the final furlong and just missed. CONQUESTA smashed through the front of the gate prior to the start but was expertly held onto by the assistant starter, came out at the start, was reserved while a bit off the rail, dropped to the inside near the half-mile pole, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch, came out once straightened and brushed with OPALITE, advanced under a right-handed whip, loomed a threat into the final furlong and finished willingly but lacked the needed winning kick. CERCE CAY was rated on the inside then well placed on the backstretch, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, came a bit off the rail approaching the quarter-pole, waited at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive while behind horses shortly thereafter, came under the whip while still behind rivals passing the furlong marker and also finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. PRAISE BAND lost her footing a bit at the start but broke with the field, went to the front, set the pace under a snug hold, was let out a notch on the far turn, came under stronger urging near the quarter-pole, lost the lead shortly thereafter, came under the whip and weakened. OPALITE was restless in the gate then popped open her stall door when CONQUESTA broke through, raced inside while under restraint on the first turn, was reserved along the rail, moved out with a half-mile to run, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch, brushed with CONQUESTA shortly thereafter, was put to a right-handed whip while on the outside, drifted in near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. GLOAT raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three wide on the far turn, moved out some in upper stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and failed to rally. UNRIVALED SCORE saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was roused while inside on the far turn and failed to threaten.
