DAVID quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, dug in gamely through the stretch and held HEARTS AT RISK safe under a steady drive. HEARTS AT RISK, close up inside, came wide for the drive and finished gamely despite lugging in while racing greenly through the stretch. TWENTY THREE RED was hustled from the outside, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GANDER, bumped on the backstretch, raced greenly while wide. HOUSTAND, hustled from the gate, raced inside and lacked a rally. COURAGEOUS COMET broke slowly and raced four wide on the turn. GROUND TRUTH chased outside and tired after a half mile. STEPHANIES DOUBLE, bumped on the backstretch, tired. MT. VIEW COMET tired after showing brief speed.
