WITH IMPUNITY, five wide on the first turn, raced with the pace from the outside, responded when roused and prevailed under a drive. ENOUGH TOUGH, rated along inside, came wide for the drive and finished gamely from the outside. FLYING RENEE quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. ENTER, close up early on, put in a run along the inside on the second turn but had little left for the stretch drive. GOLDEN GLOW raced between rivals and had no rally. RED LODGE, outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally. GOLD DAY raced inside and tired. FRENCH MANICURE tired after a wide trip. DIPLOMATIC ANGEL chased the pace from the outside and tired after the opening three quarters. XYLOPHONE, rated inside, was steadied inside on the second turn and tired.
