Footnotes

EXCHANGE BAY was rated in the middle of the pack between horses along the backstretch, closed the gap a bit on the turn, split rivals entering the stretch, angled to the middle of the track in upper stretch, bumped with BEEBE LAKE while making a run to challenge in deep stretch then prevailed in the closing strides. BEEBE LAKE prompted the pace between horses for five furlongs, made a run to challenge in upper stretch, battled gamely through the stretch and outfinished BOUND ON BI for the place. BOUND ON BI sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace along the rail into the stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded late. BUCK MOUNTAIN raced up close along the rail for most of the way, steadied while lacking room while gaining inside the furlong marker, altered course to the outside nearing the sixteenth pole then rallied belatedly. IRISH GLORY trailed to the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch then closed late in the middle of the track. RUN ALEXIS RUN , unhurried early, lodged a mild rally four wide on the turn then flattened out. MRS BIGSHOT saved ground to no avail. COUNTING VISIONS failed to mount a serious rally while racing wide. ALLEGED WHISPER chased the leaders while three wide into upper stretch and gave way.
