SOCIETY SELECTION raced in hand outside early on, was shaken up after entering the second turn, advanced four wide approaching the stretch, came in a bit in upper stretch, was straightened away, responded to steady pressure and drew clear in the final yards. STELLAR JAYNE raced close up while four wide and in hand, was urged after the leaders nearing the second turn, rallied four wide, earned a short lead coming to the eighth pole and dug in gamely but had no answer for the winner late. ASHADO argued the pace while three wide, rallied three wide on the second turn, dug in stubbornly in the stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. YEARLY REPORT showed good speed from the start, contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. FLEET INDIAN raced close up inside while in hand, angled out entering the stretch and had no response when roused. SUSAN'S ANGEL was hustled up inside, contested the pace along the rail and tired in upper stretch. A LULU OFA MENIFEEE was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. LAST SONG raced close up early while five wide, tired after the opening half mile and was eased after the first three quarters.
