A. P. ARROW was outrun early, raced wide, was put to the whip on the backstretch, advanced steadily outside and was up in the final strides, driving. SPANISH MISSION raced with the pace along the inside while in hand, was left with a clear lead after the opening three quarters and dug in gamely while drifting out badly in the final furlong. DEPUTY INDY raced in hand early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. HARBOR MASTER set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. WORLD SERIES stumbled at the start, was outrun early and lacked a rally. ARISTOCRAT chased the pace from the outside and tired. LAST SAMURAI was finished after a half mile. COSMONAUT tired.
