Footnotes

CURLINELLO broke inward at the start, was urged a bit while on the outside, brushed with STRIDING AHEAD inside the five-eighths pole, was ridden along while three to four wide on the turn, raced under strong left hand urging into the final furlong, responded well when switched to a right-handed stick near the sixteenth-pole and surged past his stablemate near the wire. JOE VANN hit the gate at the start, was asked a bit to get the lead, dictated terms while inside on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied. MUCHO MACHO MAN moved out near the five-eighths pole, raced towards the front of the field while urged, chased while off the rail on the turn, loomed a threat into upper stretch but lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. CHARLIES SWELL was forced out in the early going, dropped to the rail near the five-eighths pole, was urged along on the inside, moved around a stopping rival near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to the rail, moved out near the furlong marker and improved position. MERIDIAN MAGIC broke about two lengths slow, moved out early, was urged along towards the back, went two then three wide early on the turn, was right on top of the heels of BRILLIANT SPEED near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped towards the inside and failed to threaten. ADULARE settled at the rear of the field, raced inside early on the turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole and was no factor. BRILLIANT SPEED broke a bit slow, swerved out early, was rank while under a stout hold, lugged out three wide near the three-eighths pole, continued green into the stretch and came up empty. STRIDING AHEAD was off about two lengths slow, raced under a very tight hold while rank on the backstretch, brushed with the winner inside the five-eighths pole, settled when given his head while three wide on the turn and had nothing left. MANHATTAN MAN was urged along towards the front, came up empty on the turn and stopped abruptly.
