**Footnotes**

WE NEED V L T'S off to a good start, assumed a forward position, battled from the two path with three other opponents for the lead during the run around the bend, matched riding tactics of the others when roused at the five-sixteenths pole, engaged in a stretch duel with ELSAROARIN, with neither horse more than a neck apart, grabbed the edge soon after clearing the eighth pole, then dug in under good handling to prove best. ELSAROARIN joined in the pace skirmish from the three path, departing the half mile pole, was asked for run nearing the five-sixteenths pole, hooked up with the top one turning for home, veered out under left handed pressure in upper stretch, got put back on a truer course for a couple of strides, before swerving sharply inward in the vicinity of the eighth pole, nearing bumping with WE NEED V L T'S, all the while matching strides with that foe, was headed by that rival just past the furlong marker, attempted gamely to come back, but had to settle for place honors. ELSIE'S WARRIOR battled a threesome four wide and finished willingly for the show. GOOD TO BE ME hustled away from the gate, was taken hold soon afterwards, content to track the front runners well spotted along the rail and under a firm hold, lacked room to maneuver nearing the quarter pole, angled off the inside into a wall of rivals entering the stretch, remained on hold until sufficient racing clearance appeared, finished willingly during the last eighth to grab the last major share. CINCINNATI KID lunged at the break, loped along in the back of the pack during the initial stages, while taking the inside route, angled outward in preparation for the stretch drive, darted back and forth in search of optimal clearance, then flashed good late foot under hand urging to the finish line. OMMADON'S REIGN lacked the needed response. DIRT TRACK DEMON lunged at the break, raced within good striking position from the outside, was forced to be kept on hold, stuck behind rivals as the field headed for the stretch, angled a bit wider into the lane, only to remained mired in traffic, appeared eager to angle outward for the freedom in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths, but was forced to delay the plans until GOOD TO BE ME went safely by, proceeded to be taken out thereafter, closed in, despite racing erratically, only to flatten out during the late stages. KOMISAREK off the inside, was never a threat. CHAMPLEVE worked his way over to the inside by the half mile pole, vied for the lead along the inside with a threesome, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace, gave way leaving the furlong grounds.
