Footnotes

MORNING LINE made a three wide run to assume a forward position, vied for the lead from there with AFRICAN DIAMOND, edged clear upon hitting the three-eighths pole, was asked for run soon after turning for home, lengthened away under a drive, while drifting out during the last eighth. AFRICAN DIAMOND vied for the lead with the top one from the two path, began to lose contact coming to the three-eighths pole, but was held together well enough during the stretch run to preserve the place. KEEP ME INFORMED within striking distance three to four wide around both bends, was put to a drive heading for the quarter pole, failed to keep pace with the top one while getting outkicked for place honors as well. HEART BUTTE between rivals during the early going, was taken outward departing the half mile pole, attempted a four wide sweep under strong encouragement to enter contention, but failed to sustain the bid after entering the stretch. THUNDER PERFECT well spotted during the initial stages, dropped back after appearing to lose action, approaching the half mile pole, was urged back to a forward position while taking the inside route on the second turn, had little left for the stretch run. MAD FOR SMARTY was no menace. TWO BRASH bumped with SLEVIN after lunging at the break, proceeded along for a couple of jumps, before being forced to steady in tight off a rival's heels, angled in sharply over to the rail and failed to reach a contending position thereafter. SLEVIN bumped at the start, raced three wide around the opening bend, gave way after going six furlongs. WORTH A BUCK underwent a wide journey and folded.
