### Footnotes

THOSE WER THE DAYS was bumped a few strides out of the starting gate after bobbling at the start, moved up willingly under mild hand urging to contest the pace with BISHOP OF NOLA, began to edge away from the competition after going a half, kicked clear under a drive from the quarter pole to the furlong marker, went on to increase it, flashed the whip from the right side intermittently to the wire. BROWN INDIAN was bumped between rivals shortly after the start, underwent a four pursuit, proved no match for the winner. SOUR in the four path at the five-sixteenths pole, had no stretch response. TAPATIVITY broke slowly, angled five wide into the stretch, failed to reach a contending position. STORM ISLAND made contact with BROWN INDIAN after bobbling at the start, was the lone member of the sextet to raced towards the inside, came under encouragement by midpoint on the turn, failed to offer a response. BISHOP OF NOLA disputed the pace three wide for a half, folded.
