### Footnotes

SPARE CHANGE contested the pace, vied a bit off the rail on the turn, inched clear nearing the five-sixteenths pole, had the rider take a peak behind him for competition, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, drew off under one crack of a right-handed whip in upper stretch then another near the eighth-pole and won as the rider pleased while completely geared down late. STREET SAVVY was urged along while off the pace, moved up outside the half-pole, came between rivals passing that pole, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted three wide and was asked for more near the three-eighths pole, chased the winner into the stretch, came under the whip and proved no match while well clear for the place. SIBERIAN WILDCAT was rated just off the pace while into the bit, drafted behind the leader while saving ground on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole and came up empty while best of the rest. KLONDIKE KATE contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole and faded. SHOSHANA was ridden along on the outside, angled to the rail outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. GRACE LIKE RAIN chased the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn and stopped.
