Footnotes

HUNGRY ISLAND was reserved at the back of the field while off the inside, went two then three wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out under left hand urging in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, closed fast to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under continued left hand urging. KATHMANBLU went two to three wide on the first turn, was rated just behind the leader while on the outside, went two to three wide on the far turn, came under urging outside the five-sixteenths pole, ranged up outside the leader entering the stretch, stuck a head in front outside the furlong marker, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved no match late but gamely held the place. DYNAMIC HOLIDAY went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, raced off the rail early on the far turn, was asked in unison with WINTER MEMORIES, moved to three wide outside the quarter-pole, kept WINTER MEMORIES in at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. WINTER MEMORIES was reserved between rivals while a bit eager, continued between rivals and under restraint on the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn, was asked inside the three-eighths pole, moved off the inside outside the quarter-pole, was kept in by DYNAMIC HOLIDAY leaving the bend, raced under a drive while behind rivals in upper stretch, altered course to the inside in the vicinity of the furlong marker, brushed the rail outside the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. TRAC N JAM was reserved on the inside while right against the rail, dropped back late on the backstretch, was roused while saving ground on the far turn, had the rider lose his whip near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. WYOMIA was rated on the inside, came under urging midway through the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, was put to a drive and weakened. BELLAMY STAR went straight to the lead, set the pace with an easy advantage while in hand, controlled the action through slow fractions, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and gave way. (Rail at 18 Feet)
