Footnotes

SILVER SCREAMER sped clear after the start, controlled the tempo while off the rail, extended the advantage while still off the rail on the turn, drew off when asked for more in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under steady handling. CINDY'S JOY was ridden along while well off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail around the three-eighths pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, was put to a vigorous drive and finished willingly for the place. MALIBU SPICE was urged along on the outside, raced four wide while hard ridden on the turn and lacked the needed response while well clear for the show. VERTICAL LIFT stumbled at the start then bumped with VINTAGE HEIRLOOM but recovered quickly, chased the pace, was hard ridden while three wide on the turn and tired. VINTAGE HEIRLOOM bumped with VERTICAL LIFT at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside and retreated. SUNDAE'S A MEESE was urged along on the inside, dropped back while saving ground on the turn and stopped. ROSES FOR THE STAR was void of speed, dropped well behind the field, raced three to four wide on the turn and was outrun.
