ALMURRA came out at the start, was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch, made a bid while under a left-handed whip at the eighth-pole, battled with an array of horses in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. ZINDAYA was urged along in third position, raced inside on the turn, moved closer late on the bend, drafted behind the pacesetter coming to the quarter-pole, steadied off the heels of that rival while trying to select a lane at the top of the stretch, dropped to the inside for room, rallied along the rail under a drive, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole and just missed. STAY IN FRONT broke in and hit the gate at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, swung three wide into the stretch, angled out under a drive near the three-sixteenths, rallied into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole, battled with the top two late and also just missed in a three-way photo. ZIP ON was away alertly in tandem with RUSIANA, showed speed on the inside of that rival, dropped back near the half-mile pole then moved out, chased outside through the turn, took a short lead while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, lost the advantage leaving the furlong marker, fought determinedly into the final sixteenth but was outfinished in a solid effort. MORETHANAWARNING was last to commence, settled towards the back, went two then three wide on the turn, was driven four wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole under a right-handed whip and finished willingly. IRELAND was ridden along at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. RUSLANA was away alertly, showed speed on the outside, moved clear coming to the half-mile pole, vied near the rail on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. A LITTLE BIT SASSY was carried out some at the start, raced on the outside while urged along, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
