Footnotes

HALF A NOTE was unhurried early, moved out a bit while gaining on the turn, angled out at the three-sixteenths pole then unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the course to win going away. EDDIE C. prompted the pace three wide into upper stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. HIGHLY SPOKEN was pinched back a bit in the early stages then angled to the outside, lodged a mild four wide move on the turn and rallied mildly. LETS GET GOING was outrun for a half then closed mildly while drifting out. SECRETFAIRWAYS set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and weakened. KLASSY TRIPP dueled between horses into upper stretch and gave way. NOBLE DUTY steadied along the rail on the backstretch and failed to threaten while saving ground. GONE PROSPECTING was outrun along the rail.
