Footnotes

KRISSY KAT settled into the middle of the pack from off the inside, commenced the run around the far turn from the three path, got angled further outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole until four wide and under a drive into the lane, forged her way to the lead just past the furlong marker, began to drift towards the grandstand apron just as the runner up drew alongside with about a sixteenth to go, doing so initially after being put to some left handed stick work, carried WARM GLOW out a good three to four lanes, tried desperately then to maintain a truer course being flashed the whip from the right side but to no avail, held a narrow lead gamely to the end to prevail. WARM GLOW was affected by the incident at the start, with the rider knocked momentarily off balance as the jockey of the loose horse clutched the sides of both CYPRESS POND and WARM GLOW as if on parallel bars before lowering himself safely onto the course, took the inside route around the first turn but was off the rail around the subsequent one, swung outward coming to the quarter pole, commencing the stretch run four to five wide, gained ground readily from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole, came in slightly nearing that station, started getting herded outward soon afterwards and would continue being so right to the very end, missed. RACE PALACE patiently stalked the early pacesetter, briefly drafted behind that opponent after that one was taken two wide nearing the end of the backstretch, but was tipped back outward, into three path at the three-eighths pole and took it around the far turn, overhauled CORAL GLADE together with the rail hugging STREET DREAMS coming to the quarter pole, had the top pair soon issue challenges of their own in upper stretch, yielded to the pressure departing the furlong grounds, eventually weakening into the show slot. ENGLISH NOTES stumbled at the start, rode the hedge, had already felt the whip cutting the corner into the lane, tried to slip by STREET DREAMS from along the hedge at the three-sixteenths pole, failed, went on to outfinish that rival later on for the last major check. STREET DREAMS tracked the front runners from the pocket, pounced upon the pacesetter simultaneously with RACE PLACE, only do so from the inside, failed to sustain the move and backed away. CORAL GLADE fought against the bit while being rated on the lead, starting from near the hedge initially, then from the two path at the half mile pole, came under a two pronged attack at the quarter pole and readily succumbed. THUS offered little. SNOOKIE SLEW off the inside, was no

menace. CYPRESS POND got away awkwardly, hitting the right of the starting gate, causing the rider to lose balance and fall out of the saddle. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident at the start of the race before the result was declared official.
