**Footnotes**

JESS NOT JESSE brushed with DEPARTURES at the start, assumed a forward position before reaching the end of the backstretch, kept a watchful eye on the pacesetter, unattached to that opponent, began to move up in preparation for the stretch drive approaching the quarter pole, turned for home and was asked for run, cut into the leader's margin during the ensuing furlong, continued on ahead, poking a head down in front with about a sixteenth to go, with the runner up lurking a serious threat two lanes or so closer to the rail perhaps only a neck behind, dug in well to stave off that one's belatedly foot to preserve the decision. ZIPTRONIC was taken inward just past the half mile pole, raced towards the inside for just over a quarter, was angled outward and headed for the lane racing as a team with EVACUATION ROUTE, reaching it two wide, found his best stride leaving the eighth pole, mustered up a strong turn of foot in the last seventy yards, but came up short. EVACUATION ROUTE rode the rail down the backstretch, flip flopped paths with the runner up once that rival settled along the inside, began to swing to the outside shortly before reaching the quarter pole, done so with ZIPTRONIC tagging along from the two path, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to grab the show. LITTLE NICK showed the way on a loosely-contested lead from near the inside, came under pressure for the initial time upon arriving in the furlong grounds, got collared at the sixteenth pole and weakened. SHMOOZ TALKER broke awkwardly, was hand urged to take up position in the pocket, contently tracked the front runners, remained a prominent factor until mid lane before backing away. DEPARTURES made light contact with the winner at the start, chased the front runners around the bend, doing so under strong handling by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
