**Footnotes**

WILLY BEAMIN came away in good order then went to the front, was well rated while off the inside, controlled the tempo through the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch, responded well when shaken up after straightening for the drive, drew off under strong hand urging into the final furlong, was given one crack of a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best while eased up in the final strides. ZIVO was reserved while off the inside, came under urging outside the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed whip while behind rivals in upper stretch, came between horses passing the sixteenth-pole and got up for the place. FOX RULES went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied three wide while under urging on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and missed the place while just able to get the show. PEARL OF WISDOM went four then three wide on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, was roused while four wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip approaching the quarter-pole, chased three wide into the stretch, battled for the minor positions in the final furlong and just missed the show. QUIET FAVORITE angled in at the back of the field, was anchored at the rear while racing with his mouth wide open, lagged at the back, was let out leaving the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn, advanced into striking range but weakened. SMOKIN CANDY was reserved towards the back, came under some urging outside the half-mile pole, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside while under the whip and was no factor. I'LL STAKE U raced inside while under a snug hold on the first turn, was given free rein near the five-eighths pole, came under more urging with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn, was asked for his best near the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty in upper stretch and dropped out. LIVE FOR TODAY raced towards the back early, was taken wide leaving the first turn and pulled up near the five-eighths pole then vanned off.
