Footnotes

HORVAT CLAN settled two to three wide towards the rear, shifted to the four path and commenced a powerful bid three furlongs out rolling up into prominence four wide at the head of the lane, fought head to head briefly with NATIVE WAVE taking over the front nearing the final furlong, inched away in the late stages under a light drive to the wire. NATIVE WAVE two to three wide in close range of the leader racing in hand until the half mile pole, came under light coaxing at that station, gradually intensified the pressure through the far turn, took over the front at the quarter pole, led briefly until displaced at the three-sixteenths, ran on willingly for the place honors unable to match the top one through the late stages. VERNE under a firm hold early on when off heels along the inside, was given some rein while still in hand straightened down the backside to track from within aim, shifted three wide nearing the five-sixteenths getting put to encouragement at that station, swung three wide for home, kept on mildly through the drive for the show honors. SAM'S BUCK saved ground early on, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, angled three wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals for the last major share. EL SEASON two to three wide towards the rear, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into the stretch and made no impact. SUILLEABHAIN hit the off side stall at the start, settled two to three wide in mid pack, came under the stick and commenced a drive from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no late headway. NEVER ON TIME on the pace in hand just off the inside, came under increasing pressure from NATIVE WAVE through the far turn, got let out nearing the quarter pole under challenge for the front, was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way along the inside through the drive.
