SKY PAINTER hesitated at the start and was last away, raced on the outside while coaxed along, came under stronger urging while three wide on the turn, spun four wide into the stretch, was given one crack of a right-handed whip, switched to a left-handed whip inside the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out some while chasing the leading duo into the final furlong, was straightened by the rider with a few strides of strong hand urging, closed strongly on the outside while back under a left-handed whip and powered home an impressive winner. SUPER SKY chased the pace on the outside then three wide early on the turn, made a bid between rivals at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail, turned into the stretch on even terms with CAMDEN JANE, brushed with that rival outside the three-sixteenths pole then bobbed, dueled under a left-handed whip into the final sixteenth, got the best of the aforementioned of rival at that point but was engulfed by the winner. CAMDEN JANE was coaxed along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, made a bid while closer to the three path passing the five-sixteenths, brushed with SUPER SKY outside the three-sixteenths pole, dueled with that rival into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the show. TAPITEAO bumped with an opponent at the start, was asked early then settled at the rear, raced off the rail into the turn then dropped to the inside, saved ground into the stretch, moved out under strong urging in the drive and failed to rally. BEST FRIENDS bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was in a bit tight while three wide turning into the stretch and failed to respond. REIGN moved up to race just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, came off the rail while under a left-handed whip at the quarter-pole and weakened. PAULOWNIA was hustled to the lead, set the pace while off the inside, lost the lead while closer to the rail late on the bend, dropped out under the whip at the quarter-pole and faded. (Rail at 27 Feet)
