### Footnotes

STOP TRAFFIC flashed good speed while in hand, advanced steadily on pacesetter DIXIE FLAG on the turn, ran right by that rival in upper stretch, quickly drew off and widened while kept to a drive to the finish. RUNUP THE COLORS broke through the gate prior to the start, was unhurried while outrun early, was put to the whip midway on the turn and finished gamely along the inside to garner the place. U CAN DO IT, hustled along inside on the backstretch, was roused on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished with some interest. FURLOUGH broke through the gate prior to the start, was unhurried while outrun early, came wide for the drive but came up empty when called on. COLONIAL MINSTREL, in close attendance early on, drifted slightly around the turn and offered nothing under pressure. DIXIE FLAG sprinted clear, put up strong fractions but had little left for the stretch run.
