OUR SONG was hustled up inside, contested the pace along the rail, dug in gamely when roused and drew clear under a drive. AMERICA'S STORM contested the pace while between rivals and continued on gamely to hold the place spot. PHISH chased the pace from the outside, dropped back on the turn, angled to the inside and came again on the rail in the stretch. BAY COMMANDER chased the pace and lacked a rally. SURVIVOR KIPPY contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GRIN was outrun early, rallied nearing the stretch, was carried wide turning for home and was going well late. ABDUCTION was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally. MARRON GLACE raced wide and tired. CANADIAN FRONTIER broke awkwardly, raced greenly, put in a run on the turn and tired in the stretch. THREE STICKS was outrun. STORMIN TONY raced wide and tired.
