ZAWZOOOTH raced close up early, rallied three wide into the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed after a long drive. BOOZIN' SUSAN raced with the pace while three wide and dug in gamely through the stretch. TEMPURA (ARG) contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. SAVORTHETIME was bumped at the start, was outrun early while between rivals, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. WE'LL SEA YA raced three wide and had no response when roused. ALPINE PASS raced four wide and tired. IMAGINARY GOLD was bumped at the start, chased inside and tired in the stretch. LETHAL TEMPER contested the pace from the outside and tired. LOOKING AFAR was pinched back at the start and had no rally.
