The owner of the horse which wins all three races in the series (The Mike Lee, The New York Derby and The Albany) will earn an additional \$250,000. **Footnotes**

INDIAN HAWKE moved up along the inside to gain the early advantage, opened a clear lead along the backstretch, dug in when challenged on the turn, regained a clear lead in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch then edged away under strong right hand urging. SHUFFLING MADDNES was outrun for six furlongs, circled five wide leaving the turn then closed late in the middle of the track to narrowly gain the place. RUN RED RUN stumbled at the start, pressed the pace from outside for six furlongs, lodged a bid outside the winner to threaten entering the stretch, drifted out and brushed with SHUFFLING MADNESS in deep stretch and was outfinished late for the place. DREAMIN OF VICTORY raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground to the turn and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. ALWAYS ALBERT saved ground for six furlongs, angled between horses on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. FEROCIOUS WON stalked the pace while three wide along the backstretch, lodged a brief bid from outside on the turn and gave way in the stretch. HERBERT T failed to mount a serious rally while racing wide.
