### Footnotes

COLONEL JOHN broke in the air at the start, moved up rapidly along the inside, settled in good position along the backstretch, launched a bid between rivals nearing the quarter pole, steadied briefly while being yanked off TALE OF EKATI at the top of the stretch, closed the gap in midstretch, took the lead inside the furlong marker, dug in when challenged a sixteenth out, battled inside MAMBO IN SEATTLE while drifting out into deep stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. MAMBO IN SEATTLE was outrun through the opened half mile, continued well back while four wide into the far turn, launched a rally from outside on the turn, circled six wide into the stretch, made a strong move leaving the furlong marker, fought heads apart outside the winner through the final seventy yards and lost the bob. PYRO angled to the rail soon after the start, was unhurried for six furlongs, gradually worked his way forward along the rail while boxed in midway on the turn, steadied sharply while lacking room in upper stretch then rallied belatedly to gain a share. HARLEM ROCKER raced in midpack between horses along the backstretch, angled out nearing the far turn, rapidly closed the gap while six wide midway on the turn, moved into contention from outside in upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. DA' TARA sprinted clear on the first turn, set the pace along the inside into upper stretch, battled into midstretch and tired from his early efforts. COURT VISION failed to mount a serious rally while wide throughout. TALE OF EKATI raced just off the pace along the inside for a mile, lodged a mild bid in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. MACHO AGAIN raced in midpack between

horses for seven furlongs, was caught in traffic on the turn, clipped heels and stumbled in tight at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. TIZBIG was bumped at the start, pressed the pace in the two path for a mile and gave way thereafter. AMPED never reached contention after racing far back for a mile. COOL COAL MAN stalked four wide to the turn and gave way. TRES BORRACHOS raced up close while five wide for six furlongs and faded.
