Footnotes

PIANIST went two then three wide on the first turn, dragged her way closer early on the backstretch, stalked the leader on the outside, went two to three wide on the far turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, came out a bit when given one crack of a left-handed whip after straightening for the drive, drew alongside KITTY WINE approaching the furlong marker, came out some under left-hand urging into the final furlong, was switched to a right-handed whip, gained the advantage and drew clear under a strong drive. ANTONIA AUTUMN was restless in the gate, saved ground on the first turn, settled a bit off the hedge on the backstretch, slipped back to the inside entering the final bend, saved ground while still in the back half of the field, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out some while under a drive and finished willingly for the place while no match for the winner. KITTY WINE went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions while under some restraint, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip outside the eighth-pole, led into the final furlong, was headed by the winner shortly thereafter and proved no match then was caught for the place. STAR TORINA was eager off heels into the first turn, raced inside while under a snug hold on that turn, dropped back a bit near the five-eighths pole, moved back up with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, came off the inside under left hand urging and lacked the needed response. RAISE THE FLAG was in tight just after the start, dropped to the inside, settled along the hedge, moved closer late on the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, saved ground into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip and improved position without threatening. NEW WAVE went two then three wide while into the bit on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, dropped to one off the hedge entering the stretch, came under the whip and failed to respond. TOWN FLIRT was restless in the gate, raced off the inside while towards the rear on the first turn, came under urging near the half-mile pole, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, raced under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. MONGOS EXPRESSION tracked the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, came up empty on the far turn, fell back between rivals and faded.
